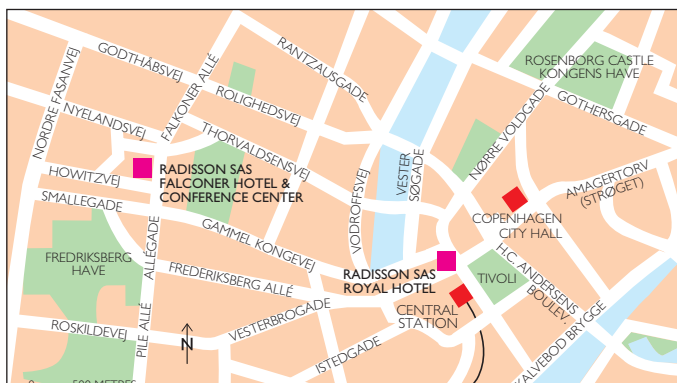

LOCATION

- Centrally located in Copenhagen in an area with shopping, bars and restaurants.
- Walking distance to many sights and close to the city centre, Tivoli Gardens and Zoo.
- 11 km from Copenhagen Int'l. Airport, which easily can be reached by the new Metro located just 2 minutes walk from the hotel.

FACILITIES

- 166 rooms including 22 suites, all with full facilities and high-speed Internet access. The rooms are decorated in one of three different styles: Art Deco, Scandinavian and Oriental.
- Fitness Centre with exercise room, aerobics, sauna and solarium.
- Back Stage bar in cosy surroundings.
- Room service.

CITY FACTS

- **Kongens Have:** The "King's Garden" from 1606 is Copenhagen's most popular green area, and for good reason. A great place to kick off your shoes, or see the Crown Jewels in fairy-tale Rosenborg Castle nearby.
- **Assistens Kirkegård:** Laid out in 1760 as a poor man's graveyard, this soon became the fashionable place to rest your bones. Hence the tombs of Niels Bohr, H.C. Andersen and Søren Kierkegaard. Plus jazz legend Ben Webster. Used as a park summertime.
- **Christiania:** In the early Seventies a group of Copenhageners illegally occupied some disused army barracks and turned them into a "Free State". Today 1,000 people live here. Tours last two hours. Politicians are getting their nerve up to close Christiania (again), so now is the time to visit, just in case they're successful.
- **Rundetårn:** Walking in circles, it takes seven and a half revolutions to get to the top of this former astronomical observatory from 1642. Enjoy the rooftop view from 36 meters up, or check out the art gallery halfway up.
